**HIS WORD TODAY** by Rev. William J. Reilly

**Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**  
July 3, 2022

“At that time Jesus appointed seventy-two others, whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit. He said to them, ‘the harvest is abundant but the laborers are few, so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest.’”

Before He ascended into heaven Jesus sent the apostles with the great commission. During His ministry He sent 36 pairs to prepare His way. The entire church today is sent on mission, to evangelize, to bring the Lord to others and assist others to discover His presence among them.

In our parishes we are sent to invite, to bring back the lapsed and to energize our entire community with the grace and presence of Jesus. Why? Because the mission of Jesus remains and we are called to bring what is still far to completion to others.

#### **First Reading: Isaiah 66:10-14c**

Isaiah instructs the people of Jerusalem to rejoice, because God would restore her prosperity. The people will better understand God's power through their homeland's restoration.

#### **Second Reading: Galatians 6:14-18**

Paul describes the sign of the cross of Jesus as all that is significant. Following the old laws is unimportant. Instead, being baptized in Christ and adhering to his ideals is what matters most.

#### **Gospel: Luke 10:1-12, 17-20**

Jesus sent forth seventy-two disciples to preach his good news, telling them "the harvest is rich, but the

workers few." He also gave them detailed instructions on how to act towards the people. Jesus then reminded them not to be happy because of their power over evil, but to rejoice in the salvation they would achieve.
